47/21 Planning Matters

The following planning application/s were considered: -

Application No: P/HOU/2021/01087 – Rose Cottage, Chapel Lane, Osmington, Dorset, DT3 6ET – Erection of garage following demolition of existing garage and erection of rear single storey extension following the demolition of lean-to.
