

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MILLS ROAD, OSMINGTON

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Mills Road, Osmington from outside Thyme Cottage to the entrance leading to Crofters (in both directions), a distance of approximately 290 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:30 until 15:30 on 1st November 2022 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3rd November 2022.

This Notice will enable Jurassic Fibre Limited safe access to carry out tree cutting and telegraph pole clearance

On this occasion there will be no alternative route, however access will be maintained during the closure.
