Planning Applications

Application No: WD/D/16/002931 - Change of use of part agricultural contractors' compound and reorganisation of the site to include log cabins and shepherds' huts for holiday use and 2 stables and storage compound and exercise compound.

Rationalisation of car parking and adaption of existing former RAF building for associated Learning Centre and Reception as well as part retention of agricultural

contracting business at Land southwest of Upton Farm, Upton, Ringstead.

The Parish Council **objected** to this application on the following points:

Osmington Parish Council does not support this planning application as currently presented. Whilst we acknowledge that the site in its current state is ideal for brown-field redevelopment, we have concerns regarding the inevitable increase in light and noise pollution that the proposed development will entail and the consequent impact on the neighbouring residential properties.

The current usage of the site generates virtually no noise and next to no light pollution in what is currently and predominantly a small residential enclave in Upton. In addition, the site's existing active hours appear to be mainly restricted to generally the working daytime.

The proposed development suggests a change to 24x7 occupancy for ten or more months of the year with permanent lighting. If this development is to be approved, then we propose that a condition be imposed that all external lighting should be extinguished by midnight and that the design of lighting employed conform to the standards suggested by the International Dark-Sky Association.

The Design & Access Statement makes no mention of noise or how it is to be mitigated. The agent has suggested that the proposed hedgerow screening will suffice. In our view, this will not be sufficient, certainly not in the short-term, and require that more consideration and design be employed to ensure the amenity of the neighbouring properties is not adversely affected. We also suggest that a combination of noise abatement and curfew be enforced i.e. a complete ban on outdoor radios, iPod speakers etc. and no noise at all after 11pm.

Our final concern is regarding the lack of a 24x7 management of the site. There is no provision for on-site supervision and contact in the case of unsociable behaviour occurring.
