#### 3. Planning Matters

• To consider the following planning application/s: -

**Application No:** <u>P/FUL/2023/05065</u> - White Horse Farm, Access road to White Horse Farm, Osmington, Dorset, DT3 6DED - Change of use of agricultural land to camping site for 45 days per year.

**Application No:** <u>VOC/2023/05368</u> – The Sunray, Main Road, Osmington, DT3 6EU – Change of use and conversion of existing buildings to residential, change of use of land to domestic curtilage with new boundary walls, associated parking, opening a new pedestrian access onto Preston Road and associated works to wall fronting highway. Alterations to the public house including: demolish an area of flat roofing and associated walls, demolition of a northern ground floor bay, the replacement of the dilapidated orangery, extension to the terrace, the relocation of the patron entrance to the public house. Provision of a new pedestrian exit onto Preston Road (without compliance with condition 3 of the planning permission P/FUL/2023/01223 – to install Timberlook uPVC green windows).
