

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH S33/12 & S33/13, OSMINGTON

DORSET COUNCIL intend, not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along Various Footpaths in Osmington as listed; [i] Public footpath S33/13 from grid reference SY 7354 8174 to grid reference SY 7338 8175 a distance of approximately 90 metres; [ii] Public footpath S33/12 from grid reference SY 7354 8174 to grid reference SY 7354 8166 a distance of approximately 100 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 30th March 2022 for a period of 26 weeks, but it is anticipated the order will be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, due to the safety implications following the landslip.

This closure is needed due to the path being unsafe due to land slip.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: On this occasion there will be not alternative routes.
