Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on Tuesday 31st January 2023 at

11/23 Public Participation Time

The Clerk read out a brief statement from Osmington History which objected to application P/LBC/2023/00450 (The Beehive).

12/23 Apologies

An apology for absence was received from Councillor C Dempsey.

13/23 Declarations of Interest and Grants of Dispensation

There were no declarations of interest or grants of dispensation

14/23 Planning Matters

The following planning application/s were considered: -

Application No: P/FUL/2023/00286 – Neptune House, Ringstead Village Access Road, Ringstead, DT2 8NG – Replacement dwelling.

It was **resolved** to submit no comment regarding this application.

Application No: P/LBC/2023/00450 – The Beehive, Church Lane, Osmington, DT3 6EL – Replace metal casement windows with new timber casement windows.

It was **resolved** to **Object** to this application for the following reason/s;

The windows should be replaced like for like or with something comparable as this is a listed building and lengths should be taken to protect the special historical interest for which the building was listed.

15/23 Parish Amenities

After an initial review of the recent speed surveys that had been undertaken throughout the village, it was proposed that an additional Speed Indicator Device post be installed near to Craig's Farm Dairy. The Chairman would consult with Craig's before the placement of the new post be approved.

It was **resolved** that a new post be purchased at a cost of £500 plus vat.

16/23 Council Matters

16.1 It was noted that an application would be made to convert existing assets at The Sly Fox and it was anticipated that the developers would be available at the March meeting to provide an update.

- 16.2 SSE had provided a quote for works to enable the BT kiosk and defibrillator to be put back online. The quote would be covered as part of the initial claim.
- 16.3 The broken stile/gate near to PGL had been replaced.
- 16.4 It was noted that the footpath near to Craig's Farm Dairy was overgrown and unsuitable for mobility scooters. This would be reported for clearance works.
