

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH S34/19, RINGSTEAD

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along Public Footpath S34/19, Ringstead, from grid reference SY 752 813 (point A on the map below) to grid reference SY 754 814 (Point B on the map below) a distance of approximately 170 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It came into operation on the 6th January 2023 and will remain in force for a period of 21 days. It is anticipated that a longer term Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will supersede the Notice.

This closure is required to allow works to take place on the caravan site.

The alternative route will go via Fishers Place, Right of Way S33/6, Right of Way S34/19 and vice versa.
